Attention All Bidders:

In Detailed Specifications, page 52, Item 2 Drilling:

Drilling shall be performed with the Cable Tool method.

Amend to:

Drilling shall be performed with the Cable Tool method or other proposed method of drilling where the well is constructed through the pull back method.

In Detailed Specifications, page 53, Item 3 Relief Well Construction

The **CONTRACTOR** shall use the Cable Tool—pull back method of well construction.

Amend to:

The **CONTRACTOR** shall use the pull back method of well construction.

Regarding a question asking how long the pump tests will be expected to last, the following clarification is added to Item 7 Pump Test:

Clarification:

In Detailed Specifications, page 58, Item 7 Pump Test

The pump tests will be Step tests. They are expected to last four hours per test, ideally with four steps, each one hour long.

Please note the receipt of this addendum in your Proposal.
