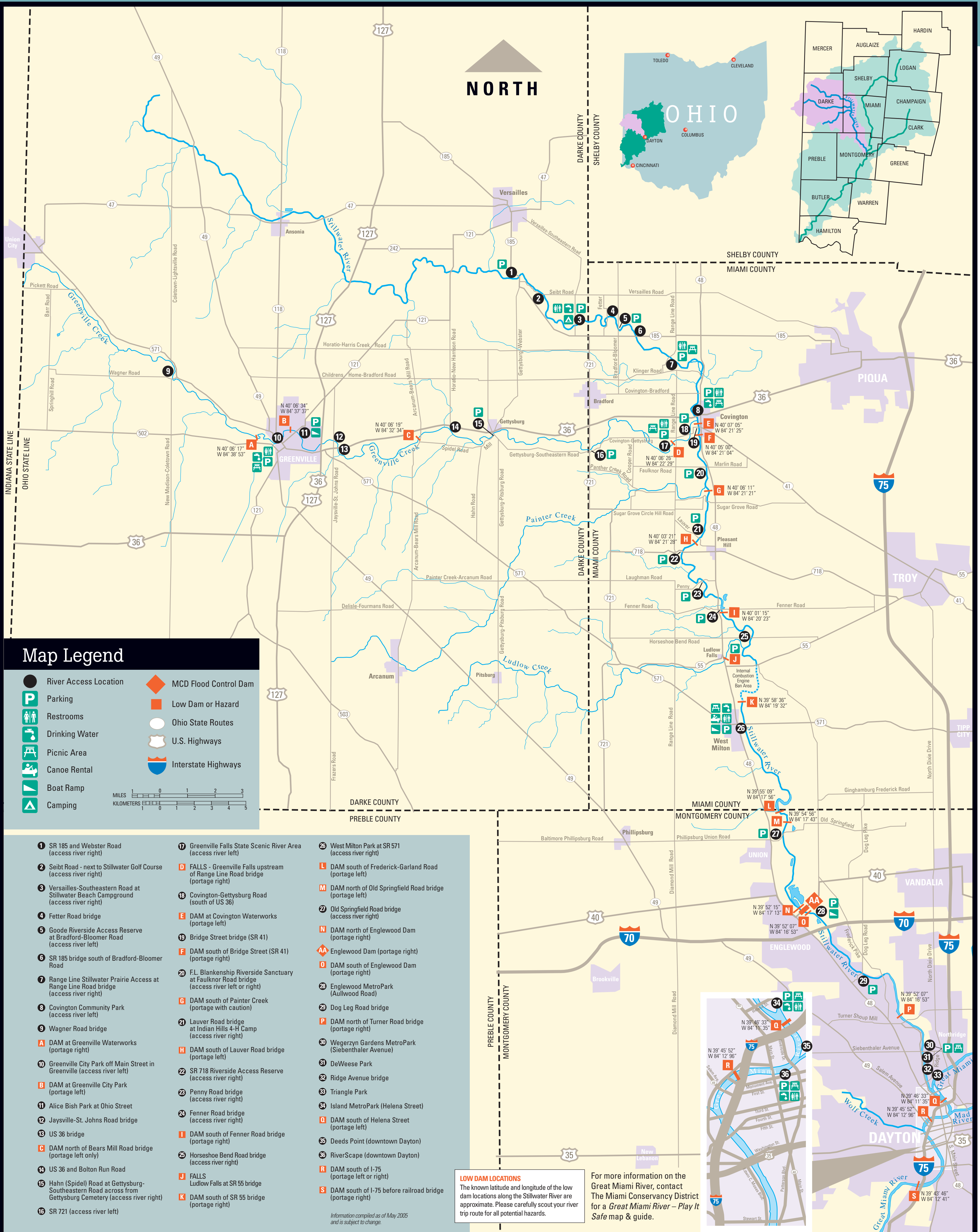


The Stillwater River

- E DAM at Covington Waterworks (portage left)
- 19 Bridge Street bridge (SR 41)
- F DAM south of Bridge Street (SR 41) (portage right)
- 20 EL Blankenship Riverside Sanctuary at Faulkner Road bridge (access river left or right)
- G DAM south of Painter Creek (portage with caution)
- 21 Lauer Road bridge at Indian Hills 4-H Camp (access river right)
- H DAM south of Lauer Road bridge (portage left)
- 22 SR 718 Riverside Access Reserve (access river right)
- 23 Penny Road bridge (access river right)
- 24 Fenner Road bridge (access river right)
- I DAM south of Fenner Road bridge (portage right)
- 25 Horseshoe Bend Road bridge (access river right)
- J FALLS Ludlow Falls at SR 55 bridge (portage right)
- K DAM south of SR 55 bridge (portage right)
- 26 West Milton Park at SR 571 (access river right)
- L DAM south of Frederick-Garland Road (portage left)
- M DAM north of Old Springfield Road bridge (portage left)
- 27 Old Springfield Road bridge (access river right)
- N DAM north of Englewood Dam (portage right)

- O DAM south of Englewood Dam (portage right)
